Conditions of Entry

Objectives:

To inspire young people with artistic talent to apply their creative ways of communicating a key message about peace: peace within the self, in the family, in the community or between communities and nations.

To encourage young artists, their peers, their families, teachers and the viewing public to consider ways of promoting peace in their own lives.

Conditions:

- Artwork should reflect the objectives and theme of the project.
- Open to students in Australia in school years 10-12.
- The art project is open to all 2D media including painting collage and photography.
- The size of the project should be within West Australia Curriculum guidelines for submission for the WACE production examination, details are available on the WA Curriculum Council website.
- Registration form and entry fee should be submitted by Monday 4th July 2011, post to PO Box 278 North Perth WA 6906
- Cheque payable to Australian Psychological Society (Psychologists for Peace WA).
- Only one entry per artist may be submitted. Entry fee per exhibit, \$10.00.
- All entries must be suitably mounted and ready to hang.
- Artwork together with artwork submission form and display information to be delivered to YMCA HQ Leederville between 3-5 pm Friday 5th August or 10-12 noon on Saturday 6th August.
- Artwork must be collected from YMCA HQ Leederville on Friday 19th August or prior arrangement with the organisers.
- Exhibition space is limited, submissions may be shortlisted.
- A panel of judges will select the work to be awarded.
- Artists must agree to grant Psychologists for Peace (Australian Psychological Society) the right to use reproductions of my artwork for peace promotion purposes, such as postcards, posters, website, with acknowledgement of my name and that of my school, without remuneration. I give permission to Psychologists for Peace (APS) on occasion, to use my artwork for reproduction without acknowledgement.
- The student will retain the original artwork following the exhibition.
- Opening and presentation of prizes will be held on Friday 12th August 2011 5.30-7.00pm.
