BASIS FOR REQUEST

In accordance with the APS Constitution, a 50% or 25% reduction in membership subscription fees may be granted on the basis of members (Affiliates and above) being on a reduced income due to maternity/paternity leave, illness or financial hardship.

Applications for membership fee reductions for renewing members must be finalised five weeks prior to the scheduled APS Annual General Meeting. The APS will not accept applications for membership fee reductions by renewing members after that date.

The following types of applicants APS applicants will be able to apply for a fee reduction at the time of their application.

- new members
- former members
 - reinstating after the APS membership year in which their membership lapsed; or
 - upgrading their membership.

On approval of this reduction, members may be eligible for the following where applicable:

APS Colleges (where College membership is held): 1st College subscription is free, 2nd College subscription at a reduced rate.

Interest Groups: 1st Interest Group free, any additional Interest Groups at a reduced rate.
